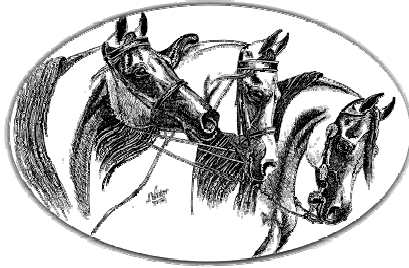

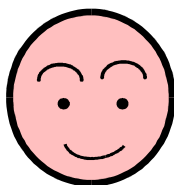

The tentative date for the awards banquet is January 28th, 2008.

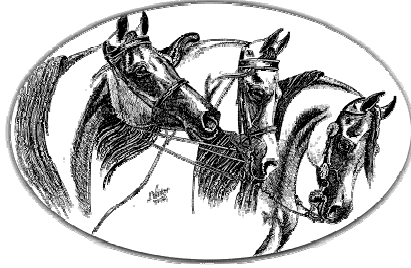
