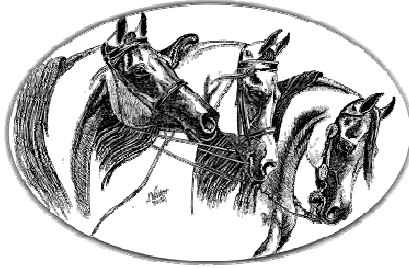

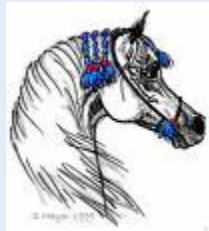

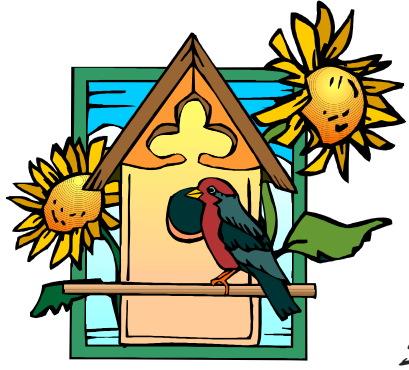

The website is up and running well.

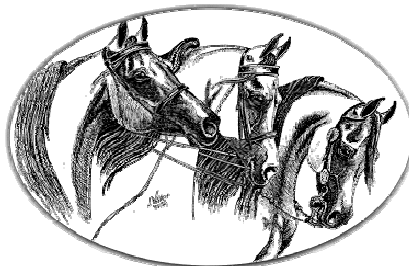
A motion to donate \$100 to the futurity and maturity was made by Char Kletecka and seconded by Dhea Lamb. The motion passed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm.

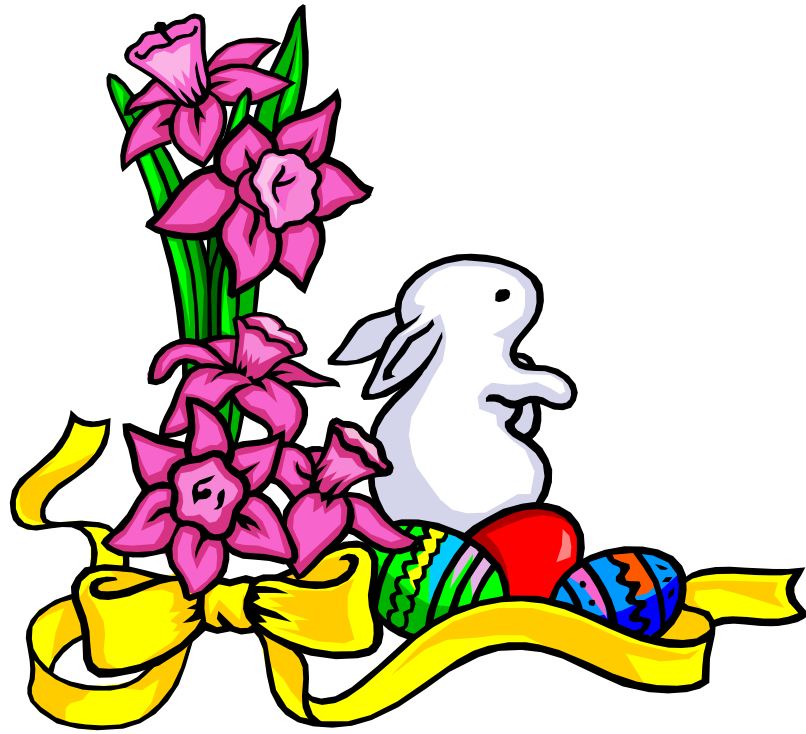
