You can enroll your horse in this data base and they can actually pull your horse out of the processing and hold it for a minimum of 72 hours. If your horse is stolen or lost, there is an alert system which sends out a message to an established list of sale barns, processing facilities, border inspectors and others. Want to learn more?
