In attendance were Char and Ed Kletecka, Laurie and Bill Ferry, Candy and Larry Larsen, Thresa Horn, Kristina Horn and Chrissy Prochaska

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 by President Char Kletecka

The minutes from the last meeting stated that there would be a zoom meeting on February 28<sup>th</sup>, but got cancelled. The meeting was rescheduled to an in person meeting on March 21<sup>st</sup>.

**Treasurers' Report:** Deb Duick was unable to attend the meeting but provided a Profit and Loss Balance sheet. Chrissy also had an idea to have the youth create goodie bags to pass out at our show with membership applications included. The youth will sponsor a stall decorating contest again this year at our show.

**Website Maintenance and Media:** Kristina Horn said that the transfer of ownership of our Domain to Deb Duick from Brooke Collins was to take place at this meeting but neither Deb nor Brooke could attend so it's on hold.

**NIAHAC Show:** Char reported that the insurance has been sent to Deb Duick for payment. The 2020 deposit for the Illinois State Fairgrounds was applied to the 2021 application and sent copies to Tony Reid and Laurie Ferry. The 2021 rate for the coliseum has increased, but the stalls have stayed the same. We will rent the covered arena for the 3 days also. We will have to follow the covid Guidelines set by the state that are in effect on the dates of our show. Treasurer Deb Duick will be unable to attend the show so Laurie Ferry will be in charge of the Championship payouts.

**ACT Program:** Kristina Horn suggested for us to reach out to other barns and inform them of our Arabian Community Tournament classes that are open to any breed.
